## **BID SECURITY**

In accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 20129, all bids shall be accompanied by Bid Security. At the maximum allowed spread rate of 17.4 pounds/sy (combined emulsion and aggregate), per page 5 in Notice to Bidders, the maximum allowed tonnages to be placed is 3,154 tons which is only 57% of bid item quantity of 5,477 tons.

- i.  $(362,546 \text{ SY}) (17.4 \text{ \#/SY}) / (2000\text{\#/ton}) = 3,154 \text{ tons}$
- ii. Assuming the 17.4 #/SY is dry aggregate application rate:  $(362,546 \text{ SY}) (17.4 \text{ \#/SY}) / (2000\text{\#/ton}) (1.15\% \text{ emulsion}) = 3,627 \text{ tons}$

**2. Questions**

- 2.1 Question: When does the county anticipate the project being awarded and constructed?

Response: The Roads Division intends to ask the Board of Supervisors (BOS) to award the contract at either the August 31, 2021 or September 14, 2021 meeting followed by a Notice to Proceed issued within a few days of BOS approval. Working days will start soon after the NTP. The County would like the work to be completed in September or October, weather permitting.

- 2.2 Question: On Page 58 of the Special Provisions, it states that This project requires the application of asphalt rubber binder at a reduced rate in the wheel path of up to 0.15 gal/SY. Will this be required on all roads or some of the roads? Also, on Page 62, it states that the Modified 339 Test is required. Is this only required on roads that the wheel path reduction is used or on all roads?

Response: The desired approach & outcome is for the Contractor to place the binder at the full application rate without bleeding or flushing; ultimately the Contractor is responsible for placing the binder without defects. The reduction is allowed to avoid or mitigate bleeding and/or flushing in wheel paths when necessary, as directed by the Engineer. Perform the Modified Test 339 on all roads.

- 2.3 Question: Item 18 on the Surface Treatment Special Notes, states that microsurfacing work shall not begin in neighborhoods until local schools have let out for the summer, typically the second week of June, and be completed prior to commencement of the school year, typically early August. With this project not bidding until August, does Placer County intend for this work to be completed in 2021 or in the summer 2022?

Response: See response to question in 2.1 above.

**3. Revisions**

- 3.1 Caltrans Revised Standard Specifications are hereby incorporated into the Contract Documents.

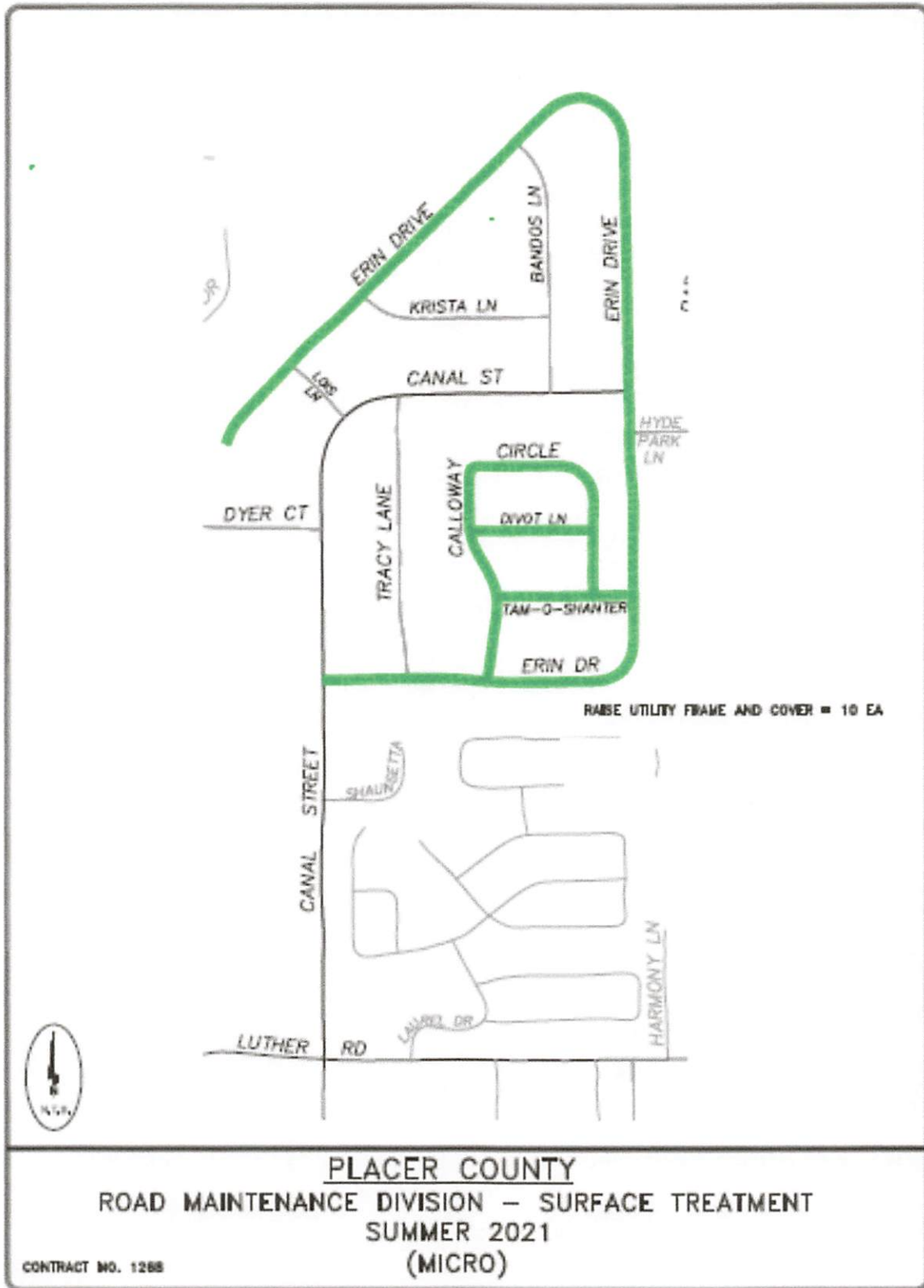
