BID SECURITY



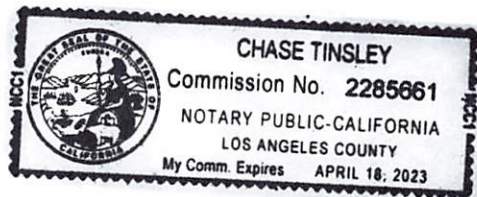

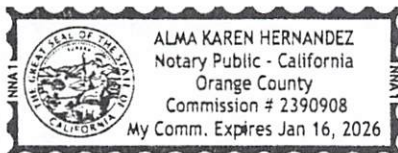
