BID SECURITY

In accordance with California Public Contract Code Section 20129, all bids shall be accompanied by Bid Security. The Bid Security may consist of cash, cashier's check made payable to the County, certified check made payable to the County, or a Bid Bond executed by an admitted surety insurer made payable to Placer County.

The amount of the Bid Security shall not be less than ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid. For the purposes of this Section, "the amount of the bid" does not include alternates, if any. The signature of the Surety on the Bid Bond shall be notarized and accompanied by a duly authorized Power of Attorney as evidence of his/her authority, if executing as attorney-in-fact for the Surety.

The cash, cashier's check, certified check or Bid Bond shall be given as a guarantee that the successful bidder will enter into a written contract within ten (10) days after being requested to do so and will be considered as the stipulated amount of liquidated damages in the event the bidder is unable to or refuses to execute a contract for the work. Upon an award to the successful bidder, the security of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned in a reasonable period of time.





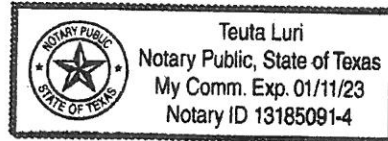
